Dear Secretary General of the European Schools, Ms Christmann,

Vice-President Šefčovič has been contacted by Mr Guirao, the representative of the parents of pupils of the Spanish sections of the European Schools. Mr Guirao has on several occasions expressed reservations to the European Commission about the conditions of admission into Spanish universities for holders of the European Baccalaureate.

In his latest letter of 19 July 2010 (attached) he points to new developments as regards admission rules further aggravating the situation in Spain in 2010. The Commission is concerned about this development and I would therefore like to ask you, as the Secretary General of the European Schools, to instruct your services to analyse these new admission rules in Spain in order to verify if Spain indeed fulfils its obligations as stated in the Convention of the European Schools.
